GOING DEEPER

- Read Matthew 13:27–30.
 - How did the Master intend to address the problem of his wheat field having weeds?
 - Contrast his remedy to the suggestion of the servants.
 - How does the master’s solution in verse 30 to “let them grow together” impact the way you live your daily life?

APPLICATION

- Jesus mentions “the enemy” several times in this parable.
 - Why is it important to acknowledge a real, evil enemy rather than vilifying the people around us?
 - How does this parable challenge or change your perspective regarding people who are difficult to love?
- What from this parable is a source of great hope and future joy?
 - Why?
