How We Live: Walk Wisely

GOING DEEPER

Who is the wisest person with whom you have been in relationship?

- Explain his or her characteristics that lead you to that belief.

In Proverbs, there are three types of people: wise, foolish and evil.

- Do you think you could recognize the difference between the three of them?
- What would be the giveaways?

Read Proverbs 13:20.

- Have you “suffered harm” at the hands of a fool before? If so, will you share the story?
- What are the results when you don’t notice the difference between foolish and wise companions?
- Why do you think surrounding yourself with fools would cause that result?

Read Ephesians 5:15–20.

- How should we go about redeeming the time we are given?
- How could the idea of stewarding come into play in this topic?
- Why are being filled with alcohol and being filled with The Holy Spirit juxtaposed?

What are some practical things you see from this passage that you need to work on? Consider these areas:

- Relationships (Wise, Fools and Evil)
- Time
- What you are using to fill your deepest needs
